Prevention efforts occur first and foremost through prayer. Prayer is the most powerful and effective weapon to combat exploitation, a modern day slavery. Action169 hosts prayer calls and mobilizes national and international prayer initiatives to eradicate a spiritually oppressive injustice.

While prayer and awareness are essential, it is not enough without taking social action. Prayer promotes effective action to combat the fastest growing social injustice of our time.

Effective actions of prevention include the Billboard Campaign, printed and published material from Action169, trainings on decreasing demand, awareness events such as the annual Freedom Race 5k 10k and the Daddy Daughter Dance-designed to strengthen the family, and decrease vulnerabilities in youth.



Action169 provides training and/or consultation to government and non-government organizations, social services, staff and advocates providing safe housing and or treatment, the education system and faith based organizations.

Danielle is a consultant to the Minnesota Dept. of Health to expand safe harbor services for women 18-25.

New Beginnings of Health, Hope and Healing

Individualized restoration services are provided separately or in addition to our Arukah program, which provides a unique opportunity to complete online and inperson therapy drawing from a holistic, trauma-informed, person centered approach. This unique perspective allows participants to simultaneously address trauma and substance abuse, while on the path of restoration.

Services specialize in addressing trauma from commercial sexual exploitation and or problematic substance use to achieve better overall health.

Group is optional, and consists of no more than three women who are highly engaged in their own restoration. Counseling offered by licensed and trained professionals who understand trauma and addiction, as well as, restoration and recovery.

EMERGENCY HOUSING

Back in 2104 the Action169 co-founders were made aware of the opportunity to assist with a safe place for women coming out of exploitation and addiction. Time, treasure and talent was invested. The room is now in use at this particular facility, and for that, we are grateful.

That said, over time it's become evident that there is a need for emergency housing in Southern, MN. Many survivors are identified in the middle of the night and need immediate safety at a time when other shelters are unavailable for intake. In addition, we've been contacted on several occasions for the purpose of safety and shelter.

If we are unable to get a victim into a crisis shelter right away, our only option is to place her temporarily in a motel, an option we want to avoid. We are asking for individuals, families, churches, and businesses to partner with us in this vision and be a part of changing lives.

We are committed to meeting the immediate needs of women in crisis while also helping them transition into long-term programs for recovery. And so, we are currently fundraising to open emergency housing, a temporary housing option to bridge the gap between getting out, and getting into longer term housing.

Projected Need and Budget Per Month

We have a location secured. The only expenses needed would be the following:

Liability Insurance - Estimated \$100/mo Facility management \$200/mo Furnished Apartment Space \$850/mo includes all utilities. Case Management \$200/mo

Grand Total \$1,250.00/mo Annual Projected Housing Budget \$15,000

We have worked in the community for 4 years and have found a gap in temporary housing for women leaving crisis situations such as domestic violence, sexual exploitation, sex-trafficking and drug/alcohol addiction. Housing we provide will bridge that gap by providing a dwelling place of refuge, hope, and healing.

PROJECTED 2019 BUDGET

To operate Action169, the projected cost without including the emergency housing budget, is \$45,596.61. Considering our hope to provide emergency housing, the total of which is estimated at \$15,000/yr, the grand total would be \$60,596.61.

Action169 will be providing three boxes of books for strip club outreach during Super Bowl 53. Books will be going to the **Atlanta Dream Center**-an organization who is hosting many other ministries and trained outreach teams. Although there are close to 3,000 gift bags going out to women in the industry in Atlanta Georgia during that time, we are grateful to be a part of reaching just some of those precious women with a copy of The Garden Keys.

Another ministry in focus during February 2019, is Reflections of Love, Inc., located in Atlanta Georgia, led by Kimberly Rice. ROL provides support, and tangible needs to women working in the industry on a consistent bases. We are grateful to be able to assist with their February outreach.

We thank God for His provision and vision, and we thank God for those who join in the mission.

FREEDOM RACE A METAPHOR FOR LIFE



53 - that's how many registered Freedom Fighters took part in the 4th annual Action169 Freedom Race 5k 10k. It took every single person, including the 14 volunteers, and various sponsors to make the race possible.

One persistent and prayerful runner shared: "There were times I was thinking, God, why am I doing this? I grabbed the wrong tennis shoes, my feet are blistering and bleeding and my ankle is not healed from rolling it. I took the wrong stroller. I should quit. And then, I'd remind myself that this is how the evil one wins. He plants seeds of doubt. And so instead, I prayed for my Momma who is angry at God. I prayed for my daughters and my son, and I prayed for the little girls and women out there who do not know their worth in God's eyes. As I prayed, my feet got lighter and although I may not have actually moved quicker, it sure felt like I was running faster."

In Isaiah 53, we catch a glimpse of some of the trials that Jesus Himself went through, such as being despised and acquainted with grief. Is it possible that when He prayed in the garden of Gethsemane, praying with the weight of the sin of the world crushing Him before He took it all to the cross, that His prayers for us made His steps a little bit lighter? The Word tells us that "For the joy set before Him He endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (Hebrew 12:2). He was willing to do whatever it would take to do His Fathers will for the joy set before Him - You! You might say He was a Freedom Fighter, fighting for the freedom of all those He prayed for.

Freedom Fighters will do whatever it takes.

Coming all the way from California to meet up with his daughter in Minneapolis and drive south to Fairmont, a 62 year old father joined his daughter for the race. They showed up as a team, a Freedom Fighting team who ran the course brimming with high hills, low valley's and open to traffic.

The race takes careful vigilance in making and marking the turns accurately so that you make it back and cross the finish line. Even if a turn is missed, eventually one can re-route back to the beginning. The point is that we're willing to keep going even when the course brings challenges. When the challenges come, we pray, love like Christ and run the race. Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead with persistence, focus and a prayer life, our steps are made lighter.

"We press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:14)

In those times when we feel like giving up or those seeds of doubt come rolling in, as Freedom Fighters, we pray instead. We run the race that is before us with our eyes fixed and focused on the prize, Jesus Christ, who is our strength, our living hope and the answer for those we run for. "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33

One particular photo of a father who ran the race with his son, was one I had to show my husband. The fathers son placed in the top three male runners of the race. Showing the picture to Corey he asked, "How did he place in the race?" Looking at the photo, I answered "His father ran the race with him." It's how we all can run the race. We make it, and we make it well, because we have One Freedom Fighter who has already made a way for us. Pray, love and run the race you Freedom Fighters!
