



Protect Children not Porn

As an NGO signed on and in support of this movement, we implore you to see the documentary film *Raised on Porn* and sign the petition.

The average age of pornography exposure is now 10-11 (we have tragically been receiving direct reports of children as young as 3) and both boys and girls are stumbling across this content, often without looking for it. Most porn tube sites have zero barriers of age verification in place. As tragic as it is for a child to become addicted to porn, the danger goes far beyond that.

2021 DADDY DAUGHTER DANCE

Prevention efforts occur first and foremost through prayer. Prayer is an effective way to defeat exploitation, a modern-day slavery. Action169 hosts prayer calls and mobilizes national and international prayer initiatives to eradicate a spiritually-oppressive injustice. While prayer and awareness are essential, it is not enough without taking social action.

Effective actions of prevention include the billboard campaign, printed and published material that is reaching concerned citizens, advocates, counselors, and volunteers of various anti-exploitation organizations. Actions of prevention also include trainings on decreasing demand, awareness events such as the Daddy Daughter Dance-designed to strengthen the family and decrease vulnerabilities in youth.

Action169 provides training and/or consultation to government and non-government organizations, social services, staff and advocates providing safe housing and or treatment, and faith-based organizations.

LOVE SUPPORT EMPOWER

Bella Daughter provides a message of love and hope, as well as support, for women in the strip club industry. Outreach happens once a month in two to three different adopted clubs in Minnesota and Northern Iowa.

Once a month the Bella Daughter Gift & Prayer hour gives volunteers an opportunity to come together, package gifts, and pray.

Intervention occurs in group settings where overcomers are given the opportunity to heal and discover their God-given dreams and intrinsic value.

Intervention includes providing direct services, support and empowerment for women in the commercial sex industry, whether still involved or not.

Survivor-led outreach and support groups for women working in strip clubs, escorting, or the porn industry are offered through Bella Daughter, an outreach focus of Action169.

New Beginnings of Health, Hope and Healing

Individualized restoration services provide a unique opportunity to complete online and inperson therapy drawing from a holistic, trauma-informed, person-centered approach. This unique perspective allows participants to simultaneously address trauma and substance abuse, while on the path of restoration.

Services specialize in addressing trauma from commercial sexual exploitation and/or problematic substance use to achieve better overall health. Support and counseling is offered by licensed and trained professionals who understand trauma and addiction, as well as restoration and recovery.

Whether you know it or not, I owe you a thank you. I spent a lot of my life trying to squeeze myself into places where I didn't fit, forcing myself to be whoever they wanted me to be.

But it wasn't like that with you, with Action 169

Rose House opened June of 2021.

At Rose House we are committed to meeting the needs of women in crisis so that they have an opportunity for restoration in a safe place with appropriately trained staff. Rose House provides long-term programming, as well as, emergency housing for women 18+

In 2021 we were able to hire a resident housing manager and contract a therapist.

We continue to look for individuals, families, churches, and businesses to partner with us in changing the lives of women coming out of exploitation and substance use.

It is always our hope to see the faith community rise up to meet this need.

In 2022, we are looking for 10 people/businesses who would commit monthly to supporting the women who go through Rose House.

People are tuning in from parts of Asia, South America, Africa and Europe - and for that, we are grateful.


