Prevention Program

Decreasing vulnerabilities in youth by building strong families.

Effective actions of prevention include prayer, printed and published material for concerned citizens, advocates and more. Actions of prevention also include trainings on decreasing demand, awareness events in schools and churches, the **Runway for Action** program and the Daddy Daughter Dance—an event designed to strengthen the family and decrease vulnerabilities in youth.

Action169 provides training and/or consultation to government and non-government organizations.

In 2023, Action169 hosted a FREE, unique webinar designed specifically for equipping parents. Attendees also received an eBook packed with solutions for raising **confident**, **godly youth in a hyper-sexualized culture**.

Strip Club Outreach

Bella Daughter

Survivor-led outreach and support groups for women working in strip clubs, escorting, or the porn industry, offered through Bella Daughter.

Bella Daughter provides a message of love and hope, as well as support, for women in the strip club industry. Outreach happens in two to three adopted clubs in Minnesota and Northern Iowa. Intervention includes direct services and support for women in the commercial sex industry, whether still involved or not. Once a month the Bella Daughter Gift & Prayer hour gives volunteers an opportunity to come together, package gifts, and pray.



Restoration

Support

We have customizable restoration services for females 18+ who have experienced commercial sexual exploitation, problematic substance use, and/or other trauma. We offer individualized therapy, as well as, other resources like education about healthy relationships and self-care.

Support also includes workshops, groups, and financial assistance for things like rent and basic essentials for a period of time.

A total of 68 hours of direct support were offered in 2023 by licensed and trained professionals who understand trauma and addiction, as well as restoration and recovery.

We believe in the power of restorative justice and will work with our clients to create a customized healing plan that fits their needs.




FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN
