PREVENTION & INTERVENTION

Effective actions of prevention include prayer, printed and published material for concerned citizens, advocates and more.

Actions of prevention also include trainings on decreasing demand, awareness events in schools and churches, the *Runway for Action* program and the Daddy Daughter Dance—an event designed to strengthen the family and decrease vulnerabilities in youth.

Action169 provides training and/or consultation to government and non-government organizations.

Bella Daughter

Survivor-led outreach and support groups for women working in strip clubs, escorting, or the porn industry, offered through Bella Daughter. Bella Daughter provides a message of love and hope, as well as support, for women in the strip club industry.

Outreach happens once a month in two to three adopted clubs in Minnesota and Northern Iowa. Intervention includes direct services and support for women in the commercial sex industry, whether still involved or not.

Once a month the Bella Daughter Gift & Prayer hour gives volunteers an opportunity to come together, package gifts, and pray.



RESTORATION & ROSE HOUSE

We have a customizable restoration service for females 18+ who have experienced commercial sexual exploitation, problematic substance use, and/or other trauma. **This year, we provided a space where 18 women could receive direct support and care.** We believe in the power of restorative justice and will work with you to create a customized healing plan that fits your needs.

We offer individualized therapy, as well as other resources like education about healthy relationships and self-care. We produced a total of 86.5 hours of direct support in 2022 offered by licensed and trained professionals who understand trauma and addiction, as well as restoration and recovery. This year, let's make space for more women to heal so they can move forward toward more stable lives—and we want YOU on board!



Rose House is a safe place for women.

We provide long-term programming, as well as transitional housing for women 18+. In the coming year, we need individuals, families, churches, and businesses to partner with us in changing the lives of women coming out of exploitation and substance use. It is always our hope to see the church rise up to meet this need.




FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN
